The **YWCA Racial Justice Challenge** is here, and I'd love for you to join us! This free, online challenge runs all month long, and you can jump in anytime. It's designed to help us all learn more about racism—how it shows up in everyday life, and what we can do about it—through short daily readings, videos, and reflection prompts.

This year, the challenge focuses on four important topics: the Age of Misinformation, Interpersonal Racism, the American Dream, and the Racialization of Crime. Understanding them is a key step toward building a more inclusive, respectful community.

At YWCA Missoula, we know that we can't truly support survivors or families experiencing houselessness without also working to eliminate racism. Families of color in our programs face even steeper challenges—more barriers to jobs, housing, and safety. The work to break down these barriers starts with awareness, reflection, and a willingness to grow—together.

So whether you've done the challenge before or are brand new to it, I hope you'll join us this month. Let's keep learning and pushing for change—right here in our community.
